05) GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

5.1. Participants Eligibility

All affiliated units must follow the following conditions in order to participate in this competition:

- 5.1.1 **TWELVE** Body Builders from each affiliated State units/ Union Territories / Government Sports Boards for Men's Body Building but not more than **TWO** Body Builders in one weight group will be allowed. The host State Association will be allowed to file two teams that is 24 Bodybuilders (A and B Team), but in each category not more than **FOUR** athletes. For Team Championship Only A team points will be calculated.
 - 5.1.2 For Women's Body Building there is no restriction of entries.
 - 5.1.3 For Women's Model Physique there is no restriction of entries.

5.2 Submission of Final Entry Form

Entry Form notifying intention of participation filled with official stamp and signature of respective unit President/Secretary must be submitted to the IBBF Secretariat not later than **30**th **December 2024.**

5.3 Travel

5.3.1 No Pick-up and Drop from airport/railway station or Hotel to Venue and back will be arranged by the organizer.

5.4 Fees

5.4.1. Men's Body Building

5.4.2 **Security Deposit** of Rs.5000/- per State Units/Union Territories/Government Sports Boards. It is Mandatory to pay the security deposit at the time of registration and in case of any damage the amount equivalent will be forfeited from the said security deposit.







- 5.4.3 In case of any extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event dates) will be the sole the responsibility of the delegation concerned. It shall not be the responsibility of the Organizing Committee. Participants and officials who arrive before 14th January, 2025 and wish to stay after 16st January 2025 will have to bear and arrange their own lodging & boarding.
- 5.4.4 **Annual Affiliation Fees**: All the affiliated State Associations/Union Territories are requested to pay their Annual Membership Fees of Rs.20000/- and Government Sports Board are requested to pay fees of Rs.25000/- on or before **14**th **January 2025 for the year 2024 & 2025.**
- 5.5.5 **Judges Examination**: All the affiliated State Associations/Union Territories/Government Sports Board are requested to submit the entries for those who wish to appear in Judges Examination on or before **10**th **January 2025 with the Fees of Rs.10000/-** with two photographs. These candidates will have to pay Rs.7500/- as additional charge towards lodging and boarding to IBBF.

06) COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 6.1 Competition for the 16th Senior Men's & Women's Body Building & Women's Model Physique Championship will be held in accordance with the current IBBF Rules and Regulations.
- 6.2 Team Managers must note that competitors who fail for weighing in within the time limit will be eliminated from the championship.
- 6.3 All officials & competitors must arrive prior to the schedule.
- 6.4 Organizers will provide free lodging & boarding to the athletes and only **TWO officials** of each State unit which may include Judges, Team Manager and Coach for three nights only. ONE ROOM will be provided per State Unit/ Government Sports Board/Union Territory.
- 6.5 Other than the above-mentioned officials, extra officials, Supporters and family members will not be provided with lodging and boarding, and free entry passes for the competition. If requested prior with the charges of Rs.7500/-, triple occupancy lodging and boarding facility will be provided.

- 6.6 Team Manager note Bodybuilders using tanning products/oil will be responsible for payment in full for bed sheets & pillow covers & wall paint stained by the same and the State Association/Union Territories and Sports Boards will have to bear the cost of the same before departure.
- 6.7 All the Officials, managers, coaches are requested to come in uniform prescribed by IBBF. Those who does not have uniform prescribed by IBBF will not be allowed to participate in any official activities and will not be allowed to officiate as a Judge.
- 6.8 Golden, Silver and Bronze colour tanning cream is not allowed.
- 6.9 It is compulsory for the participants participating for Best Poser contest to bring their own Music CD or Pendrive. The use of profane, vulgar or offensive language in posing music is prohibited under the rules of IBBF and the competitor will be disqualified from participation the games.
- 6.10 Please note: Indian Body Builders Federation, Karnataka Association of Bodybuilders and Rotary Club of Belgavi Annonstav or no other organizers will be responsible for any mischief, injury or damages sustained in travel, before, during or after the competition.

6.13 COMPETITON RULES:

AS PER WBPF / IBBF RULE BOOK – COMPETITION ATTIRE & STAGE PRESENTATION FOR ATHLETES

Competition Attire for Athletes: The competition attire must meet the following guidelines:

6.13.1 Men's Bodybuilding competitors

will wear one-coloured opaque posing trunks of a solid, non-distracting colour which are clean and decent. The back area of the trunk must cover at least 50 % of the "gluteus maximus", the front of the trunk must be covered completely, no padding allowed anywhere in the trunk; the side of the trunk must measure at least 1 cm. Pulling and shifting of the trunk by the competitor to reveal a larger part of the front, side or rear of the body is not allowed; the competitor has to ensure that the trunk stays in place during his entire performance and does not slip inside the gluteus muscles to reveal a greater part of that area. Competitors will not wear footwear, glasses (Except if it is justified by the athlete's health condition.), watches, bangles, necklaces, earrings, piercings or whatsoever other jewellery/accessories except for a wedding ring. Props including hats, caps, masks etc. are prohibited. The use of implants whether permanent by cosmetic surgery or temporarily by fluid injection is not allowed and can lead to disqualification. Body-colouring is allowed but the athlete has to make sure that the colour stays on the body and does not come off simply by wiping; air-brush tanning and cabin tanning may be used, sparkles, glitter, shiny metallic pearls or any other unnatural looking enhancements of the body colour are prohibited. Body colouring that stains the competition attire is prohibited.

6.13.2 Women's Bodybuilding competitors

will wear one-coloured and decorated opaque two-piece bikini of a solid, non-distracting colour which must conform to accepted standards of taste and decency. The bikini will reveal the abdominal muscles as well as the lower back muscles. The bikini bottom must cover at least 50% of the buttocks. Athletes have to be bare foot, no foot-wear allowed.







The back area of the trunk must cover at least 50 % of the "gluteus maximus", the front of the trunk must be covered completely, no padding allowed anywhere in the trunk; the side of the trunk must measure at least 1 cm.

Pulling and shifting of the trunk by the competitor to reveal a larger part of the front, side or rear of the body is not allowed; the competitor has to ensure that the trunk and bikini top stays in place during her entire performance and the bikini bottom does not slip inside the gluteus muscles to reveal a greater part of that area.

Padding inside the bikini top is allowed to achieve a more natural feminine look. Breast implants are allowed according to accepted standards of taste and decency.

Competitors will not wear footwear, glasses (Except if it is justified by the athlete's health condition.), watches, bangles, necklaces, earrings, piercings or whatsoever other jewellery/accessories except for a wedding ring.

The hair may be styled, make-up can be worn as well; body-colouring is allowed but the athlete has to make sure that the colour stays on the body and does not come off simply by wiping; airbrush tanning and cabin tanning may be used, sparkles, glitter, shiny metallic pearls or any other unnatural looking enhancements of the body colour is prohibited. Body colouring that stains the competition attire is prohibited.

6.13.3 Women's Sport Physique and Model Physique Competitors

will wear opaque two-piece bikini which must conform to accepted standards of taste and decency for the comparisons, the colour, fabric, texture and style of the bikini is up to the discretion of the competitor and high heels with a sole thickness of not more than 2 cm and the heels (stiletto) height of not more than 12 cm; platform shoes are prohibited. The back area of the bikini bottom must cover at least 50 % of the "gluteus maximus", the front side of the trunk must cover the front side of the groin area completely, no padding allowed anywhere in the bikini bottom; the side of the bikini bottom must measure at least 1 cm.

Bikinis that appear to small or otherwise look indecent are prohibited. The use of implants whether permanent by plastic surgery or temporarily by fluid injection is not allowed and can lead to disqualification. Breast implants however are allowed. Body-colouring is allowed but the athlete has to make sure that the colour stays on the body and does not come off simply by wiping; air-brush tanning and cabin tanning may be used, sparkles, glitter, shiny metallic pearls







or any other unnatural looking enhancements of the body colour are prohibited. Body colouring that stains the competition attire is prohibited.

6.14 Stage Presentation

The following points will apply during the competitor's stage presentation:

- **6.14.1.** Competitors will not chew gum or consume food and/or drinks while onstage.
- **6.14.2.** The use of props is prohibited unless it is expressly allowed under section 12.1. The term prop means an object, device or item, excluding competition attire that is transported onstage before a routine and offstage after a routine by a competitor and/or other person or persons.
- **6.14.3.** Competitors have to adhere to all instructions made by the onstage expediters and onstage marshals; they are not allowed to enter or leave the stage prematurely without the consent of the chief onstage expediter.
- **6.14.4.** Competitors have to maintain good sportsmanship at all the time, pushing, shoving, elbowing and other physical attacks against other competitors or onstage expediters, contesting instructions made by onstage expediters or expressing disagreement with results pertaining to comparisons being called or placings being given are forbidden and can lead to disqualification.
- **6.14.5.** In particular during the announcement of results and the award presentation the competitor will by no means express disagreement with his/her or other competitors placings.
- **6.14.6.** Competitors have to ensure that they do not stain the stage and its surroundings, especially carpets and curtains with body colour or leave hazardous materials or items on the stage that can be harmful to other competitors during or after their performance.
- **6.14.7.** Competitors will abstain from shouting, laughing, grimacing and gesticulating while on stage, even talking to other competitors should be a avoided as much as possible; the athletes shall focus on their performance bearing in mind that they are under constant observation by the event officials, audience and cameras. Even when not included in 28 comparison competitors have to pay attention to keep an athletic posture and friendly face.



6.15 JUDGING ATTIRE / JUDGING PANEL

6.15.3 Makeup of the Regular Judging Panel:

Nine/Seven judges are normally appointed by the IBBF Judges Committee to serve on a regular judging panel. Every attempt is made to ensure that all qualified judges who are present at the technical meeting are given the opportunity to serve on a panel and that all states are equally and fairly represented with no state having two or more judges on the same panel. At no time will the number of judges on a panel be fewer than five. The IBBF Judges Committee Chairman/Secretary is the final authority on the makeup of the judging panels.

6.15.2 JUDGING ATTIRE /JUDGING PANEL

Judging Attire: Judges shall be attired as follows:

- a. The official IBBF uniform for male judges at all competitions consists of a pigeon grey suit with the official IBBF crest on the left breast pocket, white shirt with the official IBBF tie, black socks and black dress shoes.
- b. The official IBBF uniform for female judges at all competitions consists of a pigeon grey blazer with the official IBBF crest on the left breast pocket, or white blouse (official IBBF tie optional), grey skirt or dress pants, and black dress shoes.
- c. The IBBF Judges Committee Chairman/Secretary has authority to remove from the panel any judge who is not correctly dressed in the official IBBF uniform.
- d. While working under hot/humid climate conditions and only at the prejudging the IBBF Judges Committee Chairman/Secretary may allow a relaxed dress code as follows: White Polo shirt with IBBF logo on the left breast together with grey dress pants (men or women) or grey skirt (women).





6.15.4 Officials

The following officials are needed to control competitions:

- 6.15.4.1 IBBF General Secretary
- 6.15.4.2 IBBF Chief Jury Two
- 6.15.4.3 Judges Chairman
- 6.15.4.4 Judges Secretary
- 6.15.4.5 Nine/Seven judges from as many different states as possible. If enough qualified judges are available, two or more panels of judges may be appointed.
- 6.15.4.6 Two statisticians.
- 6.15.4.7 IBBF Chief Marshal and an appropriate number of assistants.
- 6.15.4.8 Master of Ceremonies or Announcer.

6.15.5 Placement of Judges

The placement of judges will proceed as follows:

- 1. The Judges Chairman/Secretary will make the Nine/Seven judges sit at their respective tables and will make statisticians seat at their tables. The Judges Chairman/Secretary will then ensure that the appropriate judging forms are distributed to each judge.
- 2. Each Judge's position on the panel will be numbered using a small card (black numbers on a white background) situated at the front of the judge's table. The numbers will be printed on both sides of the card so as to be viewed by the competitors and the judges.

6.15.6 Conduct of Judges

Once the judging panel is seated, the Judges Chairman/Secretary will remind the judges of the rules of conduct, said rules which must be strictly followed throughout the prejudging and finals. Under penalty of immediate dismissal from the judging panel, no judge will:

- 1. Converse with any other judge, or judges.
- 2. Attempt to influence the decisions of any other judge, or judges;
- 3. Take photographs while the judging is in progress.







- 4. Coach any competitor, or competitors; or
- 5. Judge while under the influence of drugs or alcohol or consume alcoholic beverages while judging.

7.16.1 Doping

Dope testing may be conducted during the competition at random by the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA). The IBBF will follow the WADA, NADA, WBPF and ABBF Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations, guidelines and Operations Procedures. The IBBF is committed to doping free sport, and strict follows the guidelines and procedures of the WADA, NADA, WBPF and ABBF approved Anti-Doping guidelines and procedures for the safety of our athletes and fairness of play for our sport.
